#### **notes** from the **director**

I learned about Senior Shows at the National AACTFest in Gettysburg in 2019. When I presented the idea to the VACT Board of Directors, they were enthusiastic and told me to go ahead. We cast the show in January 2020 and were going strong when the pandemic hit and we closed down in March. When the seniors were all vaccinated, we attempted to start again but by that time, a lot of the seniors were traveling or involved with their grandchildren. So we began again in 2022 and although some people had moved or were traveling, we were able to fill the cast and finally finish this project. I told the cast we weren't giving up until everyone was playing 3 roles! During a Senior Show, we come up with some interesting conversations – for example – one night we counted artificial joints – we had almost 20!

The Senior version of Music Man is shortened but you still get all the fun of the original show. I've loved Meredith Willson since I was a kid growing up very near his hometown of Mason City, Iowa on which River City was based. His music is fun and pokes fun at the people I was raised with. I hope you enjoy it as much as I have. We are so lucky to have The Gender Bender Barbershop quartet joining us in the show. Jim Olmsted and his original quartet was in the first Music Man I directed in 1994! Thanks, Jim for coming back to resurrect your role.

I'd like to thank the cast for their devotion and enthusiasm for the production – you have made it so much fun. Thanks to Paula for finding costumes for everyone and especially transforming seniors into kids! A big thank you to Marie for finding enough instruments to outfit the River City Band. Also thanks go to Steve and Dale Nickels for handling the tech to make the show look and sound so good. Thanks go to Patty Schlafer for coming in at the end and keeping us on the beat! And to Bill Owens for handling the backstage labors! Finally to all of you for coming to enjoy our labors – you are what makes theater come alive. 
