
AACTFest Competition 2023

You may notice that the set for *The Children's Hour* looks different from a typical play set at VACT in that it is far less substantial than the usual full house-type set you often see in such a production. This is because *The Children's Hour* was VACT's entry into the American Association of Community Theater's (AACT) AACTFest Competition, which limits the size set that can be used by a production.

The AACTFest process begins with a statewide festival and winners of each state festival then move on to one of the ten regional festivals. Winners of the regional festivals move on to the national theater festival that is held by AACT every odd-numbered year. This year's state festival, sponsored by the Wisconsin Association of Community Theater, and hosted by the Beaver Dam Area Community Theater, was held on January 21, 2023.

Participating companies are limited to presenting a one-act play or a cutting of play that cannot exceed one hour in length, so the production you are watching is different from the one-hour cutting we presented at the festival. All sets and props must fit into a 10'x10' box. When the word "go" is called the company has 10 minutes to set all set pieces and props, then return to the box. The production then begins and must finish before the one-hour period expires. If the production exceeds one hour it is disqualified. When the performance has ended the company returns to "the box." Once again, "go" is called and the company has 10 minutes to strike the set and return it and all props back to the box. Once the set has been struck the company has the wonderful opportunity to be given feedback by the three AACT adjudicators assigned to the festival. While *The Children's Hour* was not selected to move on to the regional level, we were so happy to have participated in this great festival and it was fantastic to watch the other productions and see how much talent and creativity there is amongst community theaters in Wisconsin. Additionally, our costumer, Gail Gomach won an Outstanding Costumer Award at the festival and we are so proud of her!

VACT is a longtime AACT member and participant in this great festival process. We are so happy for the theaters that moved on to the regional competition and can't wait to see if a Wisconsin theater moves on to the national competition!

notes from the **director**

I first read *The Children's Hour* in a college theater class and it has stuck with me for 30 years. The fact that it was written in 1934 but that its themes are still so relevant today is both fascinating and somewhat depressing. Not only that the "rumor mill" still has great power to wreak havoc on people's lives, but that the underlying themes of self-righteousness in the name of "good," discrimination, and hatred and fear of things that are different are sadly still prominent today. This cast had to grapple with these heavy themes and it was incredible to watch them dive into this script and bring the emotion and humanity of these characters to life.

Thank you to producer Sarah Lederer for supporting this production and ensuring that all the administrative pieces came together so that we could focus on this complex script. Thank you also to set designer Alex Rosenbaum, who always listens to my fractured set ideas and brings them together with fantastic results. Many thanks to Gail Gomach, whose creativity was integral to the beautiful picture painted onstage. This was my first opportunity to work with Stage Manager Rachel Erickson, who was absolutely stupendous in providing guidance in working through many little set and staging quirks - I cannot wait to work with them again! Gina Hamon's artistic vision was instrumental in bringing cohesion and beauty to our set pieces, and Marie Kyle was, as always, amazing in providing the perfect props, always willing to chase down the things that took the set to the next level. Finally, greatest thanks to VACT founder Dee Baldock, who is the whole reason I am at VACT to begin with. Your counsel is forever appreciated.

Additionally, thank you to this incredible cast. You were tasked with bringing a powerful story full of heavy themes to fruition and you responded to every character challenge, every blocking challenge, every emotional challenge with enthusiasm and creativity. Your willingness to adapt and be flexible and try whatever was thrown at you was amazing and I am so glad we were able to work together on this show.

Finally, thank you to my amazing daughter, Erin, who I am so grateful to get to spend so much time with through our shared theater experiences, and my incredible husband, Colin, whose support of me is never-ending and who never lets on how much he would rather be doing something else when Erin and I make him run lines with us. Enjoy the show!


