notes from the **director**

The tragic story of the Romanov family is cemented in the fabric of history. Putting the captivating "rumors, legends and mysteries" of the imagined secret life of the "missing princess" to music led to the incredibly successful 1997 20th Century Fox animated film *Anastasia*. I know this film is a nostalgic favorite of many, myself included! 20 years later, in 2017, it was turned into a Broadway musical with 16 new songs and some revamped plot points and characters, which is the show you are about to see on our stage today.

When thinking about what musical I wanted to do with our high school actors this season, I knew I wanted to skew towards the dramatic so we could flex some different muscles as a cast and production team. *Anastasia* couldn't have been a more perfect fit. I am thankful for the opportunity I had as a director to take a deep dive into history to learn more about the Romanov family, and to connect my actors to the reality of the story we were telling. Though much of our musical is steeped in fantasy, it is still grounded in the tragic history of the Romanov family and the historical life and times of Russia and Paris in the 1920s, which we worked hard to portray onstage.

I can't express how thankful I am for the team of people who have been working on this beautiful production with me. Sara: Thank you for all you do for our production as our producer that we DO see and especially all that you do that we DON'T see. Kenzie: I particularly enjoyed our collaboration on this show - you captured the emotion and heart behind each song through dance and I'm thankful to have gotten to partner with you on this one. Kelsey: This score is beautiful and challenging, and you taught our teens how to navigate each number so skillfully. Claire: Thank you again for saying "yes" and for costuming our actors with such organization, love, and skill. Dusty, Kristen and Elisa: Thank you for bringing our set to life in such a beautiful way onstage. Maddie and Zander: Thank you for managing our backstage chaos with energy and positivity. To my cast - closing the door on this show hurts more than normal. I loved working with you each week and watching you learn to work together as a team. You all rose to the occasion of everything that was required of you in this show. Thank you for bringing your talent and hearts to the stage. I hope you look back on this show fondly. I know I will.

This musical is a tragedy, a romance, a family drama, a heist, a cat and mouse chase, and a mystery all rolled into one compelling story that I'm thrilled to be able to share with you today. My hope as you watch our teens perform is that you are captivated by it all and fall in love with it just like I did. Enjoy this *Journey to the Past*!


