who's who in the crew

It is because of them that I have so enjoyed this process and have found it truly rewarding.

Finally, thank you to our audience for attending this performance. While we hope you enjoy watching our cast and presentation, we miss being able to see you and draw energy from your physical presence and reactions. It has been a challenging time for live arts and we look forward to resuming in the near future. In the mean time, it is our pleasure to be able to offer this virtual production.






