notes from the director of *Singin' In The Rain Jr.*

Singin' in the Rain is the stage adaptation of the world's most celebrated movie musical. Although the movie premiered in 1952, the impact it still has on cinema, on musicals and on individual lives is still very present today!

There are three reasons this show is near and dear to my heart. First, I remember watching "Singin' in the Rain" for the first time, I was the same age as the students in this production. I was captivated by the singing, the dancing, the humor and the warmth of the story, and to this day I credit *Singin' in the Rain* as one of the first musicals that got me hooked on musical theater.

Second, my Nana, who always encouraged my love of theater, is also a big fan of this musical. She is 94 years old, and this summer I was able to visit her for the first time in a long time. In many ways, it was a tough visit - her mind and memory seem pretty far away most days. However, as soon as I told her I was directing a production of "Singin' in the Rain," her face lit up...and she started singing. We sang "Good Morning" and "Singin' in the Rain" together, and she remembered every single word. If that doesn't capture the power of this musical and how music and song can make lasting impacts on our hearts and minds, I'm not sure what does.

Finally, after a year and a half of cancelled productions and missing live theater, I cannot express how amazing it is to be working with this talented group of middle schoolers on a stage again. Their excitement to be doing theater again for the first time in far too long is truly the heartbeat of this production. I'm proud of what they've created and honored to share it with you this weekend.

It takes a village to raise a production like this one. Elizabeth, thank you for producing and keeping this ship afloat. Your expertise and insight are invaluable. Kenzie, I love watching your passion for dance and how you teach young actors to express themselves with movement. In this incredibly busy season for you, thank you for all the work you put into making this production look spectacular. Adam, this show is all about the gift that singing is, and I can't think of a more perfect person to have been our music director. Claire, I'm sorry I keep giving you complicated shows to work on, but I'm ridiculously thankful you keep saying yes. Your costumes are incredible. Matt, it's amazing to me how you are able to bring my vision to life in our set. Thank you for all your work in the set shop, for the collaboration, and most importantly, for all the lampposts. Gina, thank you for leading our painting crews and sharing your design talents with us! Sara, you have answered what feels like thousands of my questions over the past year. I'm so thankful for your patience and collaboration with me, and for keeping us organized backstage with your stage management. Bella, you've become a jack of all trades in this production, from dance captain to ASM. As usual, you're amazing at it all. Please don't graduate (kidding, sort of). Marie, thank you for finding and managing all of our props with care. Jason, I appreciated your attention to detail as we brainstormed how to light this show with creativity and color. Dale, I never take for granted how amazing you are at running sound or how much effort you put into making sure everything runs smoothly. To everyone else who volunteered their time and energy to work with us backstage and behind the scenes - from the set shop, to the costume shop, to load in and everyone in between - we truly couldn't do this without you!

Thank you, families, for supporting our actors by driving them, volunteering with us, and encouraging them to participate at VACT. Thank you, actors, for your passion, energy and excitement. I loved getting to know each and every one of you, and I hope this show is just the beginning of all of your journeys in the performing arts.

Michael, I promise one of these days I'll only be working on one show at a time. I thank you endlessly for your love and patience and daily encouragement in the chaos. As Don sings in the show - "you were meant for me." Nana - this one's for you.

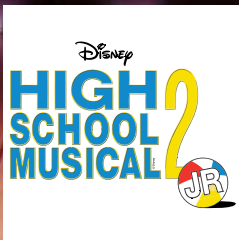
